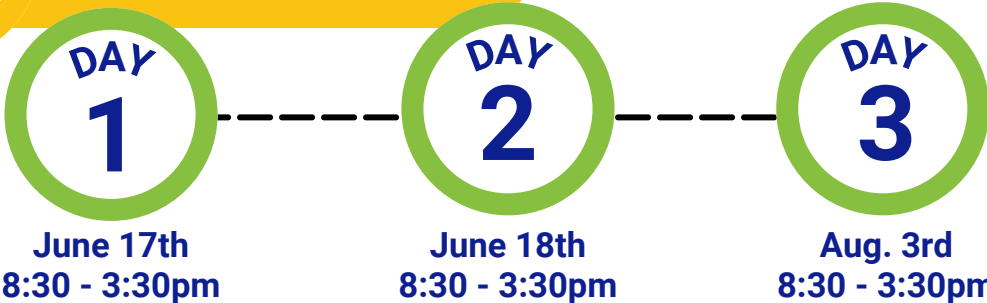


What is Restorative Practices?

Restorative Practices is a comprehensive approach to support **connection** and **community building** in schools and establish structures to repair harm. When **implemented comprehensively** and **systematically**, this approach has been found to **reduce violence, unwanted behavior and bullying**, and to **increase restoration of relationships**. When implemented within a multi-tiered structure, like **MTSS**, it significantly **improves** school **culture** and **decreases** the use of **exclusionary discipline practices**.
